PSC ADDS TWO ATTORNEYS TO STAFF

LINCOLN – Mark Breiner and Angela Melton have joined the legal staff of the Nebraska Public Service Commission effective March 1.

Both attorneys will assist all PSC departments. Breiner also will have an emphasis in transportation regulatory matters including the regulation of intrastate household movers, taxis, and limousines.

Breiner is a law graduate of Creighton University in Omaha and earned his undergraduate degree at the University of Nebraska - Lincoln. He is a graduate of Pius X High School in Lincoln. Breiner comes to the Commission after serving as the general manager of Mid-City Toyota and manager of Performance Toyota in Lincoln. Prior to that, he was a private practice attorney.

Melton is from Saginaw, Texas, in the Fort Worth area. She received her undergraduate degree from the University of Texas and her law degree from the University of Nebraska.

She formerly was a commercial litigation specialist in the Lincoln office of Kutak Rock, an Omaha-based law firm. Prior to that, Melton was an assistant staff attorney with the Nebraska Supreme Court.

The Public Service Commission has regulatory responsibilities for natural gas, telecommunications, grain warehouse and grain dealers, motor transportation, railroad safety, manufactured housing, and administers several programs such as the Nebraska Universal Service Fund, the Nebraska Relay Service and the Nebraska Telephone Assistance Program (NTAP).
