PSC PROMOTES BREINER TO DIRECTOR OF MOTOR TRANSPORTATION

LINCOLN -- Staff attorney Mark Breiner will become the director of the Public Service Commission's Motor Transportation Department effective October 1.

Breiner joined the staff of the Public Service Commission on March 1, as legal counsel and his responsibilities have included transportation matters. He succeeds Andy Pollock, who has been director of motor transportation in addition to serving as executive director and general counsel of the Commission. Pollock will remain as executive director and general counsel and Breiner will continue as legal counsel.

The Department of Motor Transportation regulates rates, routes, and services of all carriers moving household goods and transporting passengers for hire within Nebraska.
