PSC REVOKES AUTHORITY OF OMAHA MOVING COMPANY

LINCOLN – The Nebraska Public Service Commission revoked the authority of Apartment Movers of Omaha to conduct business within the boundaries of the state.

The Commission's unanimous vote Tuesday followed a public show cause hearing on April 3 at which Douglas Oestergaard of Omaha, president of S&B Enterprises, did not appear. S&B Enterprises operates Apartment Movers of Omaha.

The Commission voted on July 12, 2005, to assess Apartment Movers a civil penalty of \$500 after a hearing on a formal complaint lodged against the company. On January 30 of this year, the Commission assessed another civil penalty of \$500 on another complaint.

Neither fine has been paid prior to the Commission's action on Tuesday. The revocation of the certificate of authority held by S&B Enterprises means that it is unlawful for Apartment Movers of Omaha to move household goods in Nebraska. The revocation became effective immediately.
