VACANCY EXISTS ON NUSF ADVISORY BOARD

LINCOLN – Nebraskans have until December 15 to apply for appointment to the Nebraska Universal Service Fund Advisory Board.

The position, one of two on the panel representing the general public, is currently held by Anne Byers of Lincoln who will be term-limited off the advisory board at the end of the year. Members of the nine-member advisory board may serve two consecutive three-year terms.

Board members serve without pay or reimbursement for expenses. They work with the Public Service Commission and the staff of the Nebraska Telecommunications Infrastructure and Public Safety Department (NTIPS), which includes the Nebraska Universal Service Fund (NUSF). The Board advises the Commission on the administration of the Universal Service Fund.

Persons wishing to apply for the vacancy on the advisory board should submit a letter of interest by December 15, 2008 to Sue Vanicek, Nebraska Public Service Commission, P.O. Box 94927, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509.
