OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed with the Commission on April 1, 2002, Robert Bass dba Upper Nile Staff, later renamed Choice Medical Transportation, LaVista, Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as applicant, was issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Application B-1584. An order was entered, at applicant's request, on March 30, 2010, suspending applicant's certificate until December 1, 2010. Applicant was informed that its authority is no longer in suspension and that it must make full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations.

As of February 8, 2011, applicant is still not in full compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations; to wit: No Form E insurance filing has been made and no annual fees have been paid.

After due consideration of the circumstances, the Commission finds that applicant should be ordered to show cause on or before February 22, 2011, why its certificate should not be revoked for its failure to comply with the Motor Carrier Rules of the Commission.

O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Robert Bass dba Choice Medical Transportation, LaVista, Nebraska, be, and it is hereby ordered to show cause why its Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity should not be revoked for failure to comply with Commission rules on or before February 22, 2011, and a hearing was set for March 1, 2011, at 1:30 p.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln.
