OPINION AND FINDINGS

By application filed July 18, 2011, T & T Limousine Service, LLC, Norfolk, hereinafter referred to as applicant, seeks to operate as a common carrier of passengers by motor vehicles in Supplement 3 in Certificate of Authority B-1783 as follows:

AUTHORITY SOUGHT

Transportation of passengers by bus in charter and special party service between points in Nebraska over irregular routes. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: No.

A timely protest to the granting of this application was filed on July 22, 2011, by VIP Limousine. On August 19, 2011, an amendment was filed to the original application by the applicant and signed by the protestant. On August 19, 2011, VIP Limousine withdrew its protest, Application No. B-1783, Supplement 3 was then processed pursuant to Rule 018.03 of the Rules of Procedure of the Commission.

After due consideration of the evidence and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission is of the opinion and finds:

1. Applicant is fit, willing, and able properly to perform the service proposed and to conform to the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat., Sections 75-301 to 75-322.04, (Reissue 2003), and the requirements, rules and regulations of the Commission thereunder.

2. The proposed intrastate service is or will be required by the present or future public convenience and necessity to the following extent:

## CERTIFICATE AUTHORIZED

SERVICE AND TERRITORY AUTHORIZED: COMMON: Transportation of passengers by bus in charter and special party service between all points in Nebraska. RESTRICTION: No transportation to originate in Douglas, Sarpy, Cass and Lancaster counties. RESTRICTION: No transportation to originate in Washington County except that transportation may originate in or within two miles of the City of Arlington in Washington County. RESTRICTION: The transportation of railroad train crews and their baggage is not authorized. HHS Designation: No.

## O R D E R

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. B-1783, Supplement 3, be, and it is hereby granted as amended; and that upon compliance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Order, a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity shall be issued to T & T Limousine Service, LLC, Norfolk, Nebraska, in Application No. B-1783, Supplement 3, authorizing the operations set forth in the foregoing findings.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall not be issued the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity in Supplement 3 authorized by the Commission unless and until applicant has fully complied, within a reasonable time from the effective date of this Order, with Neb. Rev. Stat., Sections 75-305 (fees), 75-207 (insurance), and 75-308 (rates), (Reissue 1996), and with the rules and regulations of the Commission; and if upon expiration of such time, applicant has not complied with such terms and conditions, this order shall, after reasonable notice to applicant, be of no further force and effect.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall not conduct the operations until a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity is issued.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicant shall render reasonably continuous and adequate service to the public pursuant to the authority authorized.
